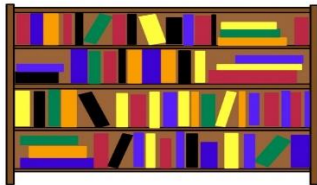

“Cardinals Walk” Club



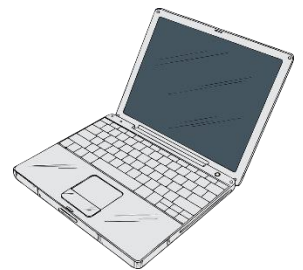
